MCFD Summative Examination 2020 Call for QA Assessors

This year the Malta College of Family Doctors will be holding the Applied Knowledge Test (AKT) on Friday, 30th October 2020. The submission deadline for the Recorded Consultation Assessment (RCA) is Saturday, 31st October 2020.

As such the College is seeking quality assurance (QA) assessors (also acting as stand-in examiners in case of need) to take part in both AKT and RCA, and their preparatory and training sessions.

Applicants need to:

- 1. be paid-up full Members of the Malta College of Family doctors (MMCFD)
- 2. be Specialists in Family Medicine
- 3. be practising Family Medicine for at least five years
- 4. be currently practising Family Medicine at least 20 hours a week
- 5. be of good standing with the MCFD and the Medical Council

Past experience in Quality Assurance will be considered an asset, however the College will provide the necessary training to doctors who are interested in applying for the post, free of charge.

GP Trainers of trainees who will undertake any or both parts of the MCFD Summative Assessment 2020 or relatives to the third degree of trainees who will undertake any or both parts of the MCFD Summative Assessment 2020 are excluded from applying for these posts.

Successful applicants will be remunerated €240.

Applications will be accepted until **Friday, 16th October 2020**. Please send a detailed curriculum vitae with a covering letter stating your interest in participating to **secretary@mcfd.org.mt**
