**MMCFD Summative Examination 2021
Recorded Consultation Assessment
Call for Examiners**

The Malta College of Family Doctors will be holding the MMCFD Summative Examination 2021. The **AKT** will be held on **08th October 2021**. The submission deadline for the **RCA** is **09th October 2021**.

In view of this, the College is opening a call for applications for **examiners**. The selected applicants will be required to undergo examiner training. A report must be submitted to the Examination Board by each examiner after the examination.

Applicants for examiners will need to satisfy the following criteria:

- Be paid-up full members of the Malta College of Family Doctors
- Be practising as Specialists in Family Medicine for at least 30 months
- Be currently practicing Family Medicine for at least 20 hours per week
- Be ready to sign a 'no conflict of interest' declaration and a confidentiality agreement
- Be trained GP trainers OR have undergone an Assessment Course or Examiner Training in Family Medicine OR have successfully completed the Specialist Training Programme in Family Medicine
- Be of good standing with the MCFD and the Medical Council

GP Trainers of candidates sitting for the above-mentioned examination or relatives up to the 3rd degree of candidates sitting for the above-mentioned examination cannot apply for this

post.

Chosen applicants are required to attend AKT item writing and RCA examiner training.

Successful applicants will be remunerated **€500**.
