MCFD Summative Examination 2021 Call for QA Assessors

The Malta College of Family Doctors will be holding the Applied Knowledge Test on Friday, 8th October 2021. The submission deadline for the Recorded Consultation Assessment is Saturday, 9th October 2021.

The College is seeking quality assurance (QA) assessors (also acting as stand-in examiners in case of need) to take part in both assessment sessions, and preparatory sessions including the Angoff process and any training sessions organised by MCFD.

Applicants need to:

- 1. be paid-up full Members of the Malta College of Family doctors (MMCFD)
- 2. be Specialists in Family Medicine
- 3. be practising Family Medicine for at least five years
- 4. be currently practising Family Medicine at least 20 hours a week
- 5. be of good standing with the MCFD and the Medical Council

Past experience in Quality Assurance will be considered an asset, however the College will

provide the necessary training to doctors who are interested in applying for the post, free of

charge.

GP Trainers of trainees who will undertake any or both parts of the MCFD Summative Assessment

2021 or relatives to the third degree of trainees who will undertake any or both parts of the MCFD

Summative Assessment 2021 are excluded from applying for these posts.

Successful applicants will be remunerated €240.
