MMCFD SUMMATIVE EXAMINATION 2021

APPLIED KNOWLEDGE TEST

Call for Members of Angoff Group

The Malta College of Family Doctors will be holding the Applied Knowledge Test (AKT) of the MMCFD Summative Examination on **Friday, 8th October 2021**.

In view of this, the College is opening a call for applications for members to sit on the Angoff group. The Angoff process is the means of standard setting for the AKT.

The process will take place over two evenings:

Wednesday, 13th October and **Thursday, 14th October 2021**. Both sessions will start at **19:00**.

Applicants will need to satisfy all of the following criteria:

- Be paid-up members of the Malta College of Family Doctors
- Be practising as Specialists in Family Medicine
- Be currently practising Family Medicine for at least 20 hours per week
- Be ready to sign a “no conflict of interest” declaration and a confidentiality agreement
- Be of good standing with the MCFD and the Medical Council.

GP Trainers of candidates sitting for the above-mentioned examination, and relatives up to 3rd degree of candidates sitting for the above-mentioned examination **cannot** apply for the post.

The MCFD council is looking for:

- 3 recent graduates from the Specialist Training Programme in Family Medicine (STPFM) (less than 2 years on the Specialist Accreditation register)
- 3 graduates of the STPFM who have been on the Specialist Accreditation register for at least 2 years, and
- 3 others from the Family Medicine specialist pool

Successful applicants will be remunerated €80 per session for the participation in the Angoff process. The Council's decision on selection is final.
