## MMCFD Summative Examination 2023 Applied Knowledge Test Call for Members of the Angoff Group

The Malta College of Family Doctors will be holding the Applied Knowledge Test (AKT) of the MMCFD Summative Examination on Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023. In view of this, the College is opening a call for applications for members to sit on the Angoff group. The Angoff process is the means of standard setting for the AKT.

The process will take place on two evenings: <u>Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October</u> and <u>Thursday 12<sup>th</sup></u> October 2023. Both sessions will start at 19:30 hrs. and will be held at The Professional Centre, 127, Sliema Road, Gzira.

The Malta College of Family Doctors is looking for 10 Angoff members who satisfy the following criteria:

- Be paid-up members of the Malta College of Family Doctors.
- Be practising as Specialists in Family Medicine.
- Be currently practising Family Medicine for at least 20 hours per week.
- Be ready to sign a "no conflict of interest" declaration and a confidentiality agreement.
- Be of good standing with the MCFD and the Medical Council.

GP Trainers of candidates sitting for the above-mentioned examination, and relatives up to  $3^{rd}$  degree of candidates sitting for the above-mentioned examination <u>cannot</u> apply for the post.

Successful applicants will be remunerated €80 for participation in the Angoff process. The Council's decision on selection is final.
