RATIONALE

Emotions are universal human response to internal and external stimuli. They play an important role in our states of health and disease and in our relationships. It is necessary for family doctors to be able to recognize and accept emotions in themselves and in their patients, and to be able to modify them when necessary. This is a course for teachers of family medicine at all levels that will allow participants to understand emotions and to explore how we can teach this subject to our students, trainees, and colleagues. This year we will also focus on methods of assessment of learning as there has been demand for this in previous courses.

AIMS

At the end of this course the learner will be able to design a module on teaching and learning about emotion in family medicine.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

At the end of the course the learner will:

- be able to define emotion
- be able to recognize emotions in themselves, in patients, and in learners
- be able to describe the ways that emotions are involved in salutogenesis (staying healthy), pathogenesis, and coping with chronic disease
- be able to list ways that family medicine can modify emotions when necessary
- be able to list the methods used in the assessment of acquisition of knowledge, skills, and attitudes related to emotion
- value the central role of emotion in family medicine.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The course is aimed at educators in primary care who are involved in teaching at the university or practice level. It aims teachers at all levels that will allow participants to understand emotions and to explore how we can teach this subject to our students, trainees, and colleagues. Final year medical students will also participate at the course to add the learners' perspective and enrich a collaborative learning experience.
