

Call for Abstracts: MAP Annual Conference 2 & 3 October 2024

United Minds: Enhancing Collaborative Care in Psychiatry

Instructions for Abstract Submission: Deadline 31 August 2024

- The Abstracts being considered should be on any topic related to Mental Health
- Abstracts are to be typed and submitted as a 1-page Word document uploaded in the application form found on www.map.org.mt.
- The Abstract title must contain no abbreviations.
- List the full name of the submitting author and co-authors, including titles and their affiliations.
- Abstracts should be no more than 300 words (count not including titles/affiliations).
- Submissions must clearly state the aims, methods and results of the study.
- Abstracts reporting research findings must be presented in five headed paragraphs in the following order: Aims and Hypothesis, Background, Method, Results and Conclusions.
- Submissions are accepted on the understanding that the work has been performed with the permission of any relevant ethical or legislative body. The authors should therefore ensure the work was conducted with appropriate ethical and governance safeguards.
- All sources of financial sponsorship of the study should be stated at the end of the abstract.
- Bibliographic references, tables and appendices are not to be included in the abstract.
- Authors of abstracts chosen for a short oral presentation will be requested to submit their final version of their presentation in Powerpoint format by the 22 September 2024.
- Please fill in a separate application for each abstract if more than one abstract.
