

BIOGRAPHY

Dr Shabbir Moochhala

Dr Moochhala is a Consultant Nephrologist at the Royal Free Hospital in London. He trained in Edinburgh and Newcastle upon Tyne, and has a special interest in renal physiology. His PhD examined pyrophosphate transport physiology in the kidney. He runs the Metabolic Renal Stone clinical service at the Royal Free Hospital, and was mentored by Professor Robert Unwin. Shabbir contributes at international level to kidney research and education. He is Principal Investigator for four international clinical trials and is national chair of Rare Disease Groups and an NHS Rare Disease Collaborative Network.






The Valletta Local Council Townhall

The Valletta Local Council, located on the site of the former Café Premier, is situated in the ground floor of the impressive Bibliotheca building in Republic Square.

The origins of the Bibliotheca date back to 1776 when the decision to establish a public library in Malta was made by the Grand Master of the Order of St. John, Emmanuel de Rohan-Polduc. This was part of a broader initiative to promote education and literacy among the Maltese population. The current building, a masterpiece of neoclassical design, was designed



by the Polish-Italian architect Stefano Ittar and constructed between 1786 and 1796.

The building's façade, adorned with Corinthian columns and ornate cornices, is an imposing yet elegant sight that adds to the historic charm of Republic Square, where it is located.

The library's holdings include a wide range of books, manuscripts, and archival materials that span several centuries. Among the most treasured items in the collection are the archives of the Order of St. John, which include documents dating back to the 12th century.


